For those of you that wish to set up Friday night, the committee will allow it; however, be reminded that the Floydada Chamber of Commerce/Punkin Day Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage. Please remember in working with the Floydada folks that they are volunteers and are doing the best they can.
2. We require exhibits to be up by 9:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Exhibits must remain open and maintained from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Exhibitors will be responsible for collecting sales tax. There is no commission on sales.
3. The committee reserves the right to ban any exhibitor for misconduct, obscene or offensive work, and the right to approve or disapprove the sale, display or distribution of all merchandise sold on the premises.
4. The committee will not tolerate verbal or physical abuse to volunteers, other vendors or visitors. You will be asked to leave immediately without a refund.
5. Vendors will clean up trash from their booth using dumpsters that are provided.

Please notify the Chamber office at 806/983-3434 a week before the event if you will not be able to attend. No shows will not be invited back.
